This Errata Notice to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico's Financial Information and Operating Data Report dated November 6, 2015 (the "Commonwealth Report") is published to substitute the table titled "Commonwealth Governmental Funds Deficiencies of Revenues over Expenditures (Modified Accrual Basis)" on page 66 of the Commonwealth Report for the table presented below. This Errata Notice corrects an inadvertent error in the "Total Expenditures" line item for fiscal year 2014 under the columns of "Other Governmental" and "Total Governmental". The parentheses in the number \$1,140,433 under the "Other Governmental" column are eliminated resulting in "Total Expenditures" of \$21,620,133 under the "Total Governmental" column, instead of \$19,339,267. The "Excess (Deficiency) of Revenues over Expenditures" for fiscal year 2014 appearing on that table remains (\$4,309,879). Except for the information contained in the table below, the Commonwealth is not updating the Commonwealth Report.
